

Boundary mark Luzný / Lusen (Czech Rep. – Bayern boundary mark X30-18-0-1)

Boundary mark Luzný / Lusen was fitted in place in 1772. It marks the boundary between the Kingdom of Bohemia, the Duchy of Bavaria and the "Hochstift Passau". Coat of arms of respective territory is sculpted on each side of the boundary mark.

The boundary mark is protected by the law as active boundary mark. The boundary mark is on the border of National park Šumava and Nationalpark Bayerischer Wald, therefor the access is restricted to marked pathways.

Aprox. 300 meters from the boundary mark, at the top of the Luzný / Lusen mountain, there was established trigonometric point that was involved in Stable cadastre triangulation.
